THIS WEEK'S LESSON: FAITH ALLOWS US TO HAVE GRACE



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week:

Today we learned that our sin is a big mess and only Jesus can get us clean from it. When we put our faith in him, he promises to wash our sins away. 1 John 1:9, Luke 7:36-50, Jesus Forgives a Sinful Woman



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Do this week's experiment at home with the kids, and then ask them what this experiment has to do with what we learned about sin.



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- Who came to visit Jesus when he was at dinner with the Pharisee?
- Why did Jesus forgive her sins?
- How can we be forgiven for our sins?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"Now faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see."

Hebrews 11:1 (NIV)



PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

The most important decision anyone can ever make is asking Jesus to be their Savior. Talk to your kids about that decision this week. Share when you received Jesus as your Savior. If they are ready to make that step, encourage them to do so!

HANDS-ON FAITH

CRAFT ACTIVITY

Saline Slime (This is the recipe used in the video but the slime did not form properly and really did make a mess, therefore we recommend using Elmer's Magical Liquid to make your slime)

Items needed:

- 1/2 cup Elmer's washable glue
- 1/4 teaspoon baking soda (Bi-Carb Soda)
- buffered saline solution
- Mixing bowl
- Mixing spoon

Saline Slime Directions:

- Mix glue and baking soda very well.
- Slowly add a few drops of saline, mixing well.
- Keep adding saline until mixture is a stringy ball.
- Wet hands with a few drops of saline and continue to mix slime until the consistency improves.
- If slime is still too sticky add several more drops of saline and knead slime until desired consistency is achieved.

Elmer's Glue and Magical Liquid Slime:

Follow the instructions provided on the Magical Liquid bottle.

Let the slimy fun begin!

Slime can be stored in a Ziplock bag when not in use.

What does it mean?

Sin is messy, but when we have faith, Jesus will forgive our sins.
